STRUCTO-INJECT 1390

VERY LOW VISCOSITY EPOXY INJECTION RESIN

PRODUCT DESCRIPTION

Structo-Inject 1390 is a 2-component, solvent-free injection resin with very low viscosity for injection into cracked concrete.

APPLICATION

Structo-Inject 1390 is used for the structural repair of cracks in concrete columns, beams, wooden spans and anchoring threaded bars into concrete and cracks in masonry, etc.

CHARACTERISTICS

- Very low viscosity.
- · Good penetration, even into hairline cracks.
- Very good adhesion to concrete, wood and metal.
- · High mechanical characteristics.
- Rapid-hardening.
- Improved pot life over standard injection resin Structo-Inject 1380.

APPLICATION

If using a dual component injection device it is important to maintain the mixing ratio of A/B = 3:1. Before injection is carried out, cracks should be sealed at the surface with a quick-setting mortar or a thixotropised epoxy primer.

The injection ports should be equally spaced along the length of the crack; the interval between should be the same as the thickness of the concrete being injected. After thorough mixing of the two components, inject the Structo-Inject 1390 into the crack with the correct injection equipment (injection pump, grease gun or crackinjector). The injection pressure depends on the size of the crack and working methods, etc.

CONSUMPTION

Dependant on the surface being injected.

SIZES AND WEIGHTS

Standard packaging: 10 kg A / 3 kg B.

CLEANING

Uncured product can be removed with acetone.
